

# Looking for somewhere to work or relax at the UCL Institute of Education?

*The Newsam Library has 250 seats and offers a variety of types of space*



## Level 3 (Silent) –

- 18 desks with PCs
- 58 study spaces (40 with power sockets)
- 5 individual study pods



## Level 4

- 3 PC Labs (58 spaces) – sometimes these rooms may be booked
- 6 desks with PCs in the library; 33 study spaces
- 2 bookable group study rooms; a selection of comfortable chairs and sofas, some with tables
- Library teaching room can be used when not booked



## Level 5 (Silent) –

- 12 desks with PCs
- 57 study spaces (24 with power sockets)

*However, sometimes, the library can get very busy though, so here are some other options*

- PC Lab 4 (24 hour access – may be booked for teaching during the daytime)
- Level 4 entrance area – seating tables and café
- Students Union's Institute Bar (Level 3)

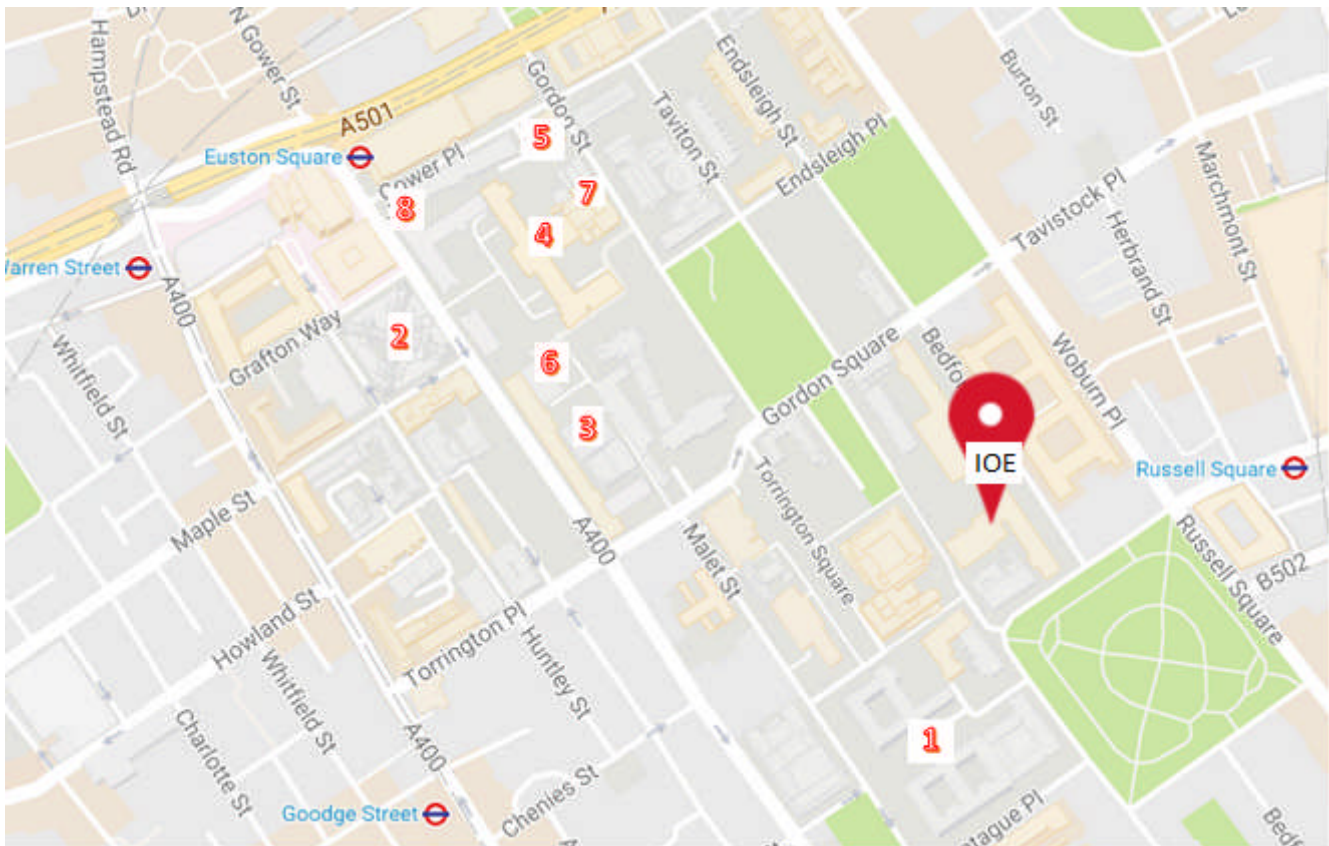
